**Proposed Enlargement and Increase in the Planned Admission Number
of St Mary Magdalene Church of England Primary School -
A Voluntary Aided School**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that St Mary Magdalene Church of England Primary School Governing Body intends to make a prescribed alteration to St Mary Magdalene Church of England Primary School, Kingsman Street, Woolwich, London SE18 5PW, a Voluntary Aided School, by providing additional accommodation on a second site on the Greenwich Peninsula with effect from 01 September 2014.

It is proposed to expand the school by the provision of an additional site and accommodation for the school on John Harrison Way, and increase the planned admission number for each year group from 60 places currently, to 120 places with effect from the September 2014. The admission number of the school will increase to 120 for Reception Year in 2014/15, 120 for Year 1 in 2015/16, and so on until 2020/21, when the admission number for all year age groups will be 120. The proposal includes a variation to the school's admissions criteria for the proposed Peninsula school site, for children starting school from September 2015.

The admission capacity of the school for children aged 4-11 is currently 420 places and the proposed admission capacity will be 840 places, across both sites.

The current capacity of the school is 420 and the proposed capacity will be 840. The current number of pupils aged 4-11 registered at the school is 352. The current admission number for the school is 60 and the proposed admission number will be 120.

This Notice is an extract from the complete proposal and is published following consultations with interested parties in the areas served by the school in November and December 2013.
