NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON NEW CONSERVATION AREAS AND ADDITIONS TO THE LOCAL HERITAGE LIST IN CHARLTON RIVERSIDE

Royal Borough of Greenwich is inviting public representations on a proposal to create two new conservation areas in Charlton Riverside. The Royal Borough is also proposing to add several buildings in Charlton Riverside to the Borough's Local Heritage List. Royal Borough of Greenwich has a legal duty to designate conservation areas.

The Royal Borough is consulting on the proposed locations of the new conservation area boundaries and on the merits of the buildings recommended for the Local Heritage List. The Royal Borough is inviting views on the proposed conservation area boundaries and architectural and historic interest of the two areas and the architectural, historic or environmental merits of the proposed locally listed buildings.

The consultation is open from **13 December 2017** to **17 January 2018**. Consultation documents are available to view on the Royal Borough's website at www.royalgreenwich.gov.uk/haveyoursay. All relevant representations will be considered. The consultation responses, with any resulting changes to the conservation area boundaries, will be reported back to the Royal Borough's Cabinet for agreement, so that the conservation areas and locally listed buildings can be designated.
