

Notice of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations 2019

Notice is hereby given that Royal Borough of Greenwich is conducting a review of the Parliamentary polling districts and polling places that fall within its boundaries. This review is required by Section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

This is a full review of all polling districts and polling places. It is not a review of any Parliamentary Constituency, Ward or other electoral boundary. It reviews how each current Parliamentary Constituency should be divided into polling districts and which polling place the electors voting in person in that polling district must go to vote.

This review will also be a review of Local Government polling districts and polling places and will mirror any change to the parliamentary arrangements so that polling districts and places for both remain coterminous.

The proposals will be made public on the Council's website. The (Acting) Returning Officer for each constituency will comment on proposed polling places and the stations that would then be used.

Representations may be made about the arrangements, proposals and their accessibility for electors as well as on the (Acting) Returning Officer's representation.

The Council welcomes input from any elector resident within the district. The Council additionally welcomes views and representations regarding accessibility for voters with disabilities or mobility issues, including from bodies or persons with experience or expertise on these issues.

Representations can be made by email to elect@royalgreenwich.gov.uk or by post to Electoral Services, Town Hall, Wellington Street, London, SE18 6PW. Details of those representations made will be published on the Council's website.

The review will run from 15 August and any person or body may make representations until 27 September. Recommendations will be presented to Full Council to consider. Any changes will be implemented on the revised register of electors to be published on 1 December 2019.
