Report / representation of the relevant Acting Returning Officers

As required by law, the Acting Returning Officers who are responsible for any part of the area of the Royal Borough of Greenwich must consider the proposed polling districts and polling places and comment on their suitability for the holding of polling and give comment on any place that is proposed that may not be suitable.

For the Greenwich and Woolwich and Eltham Constituencies, Debbie Warren (RBG Chief Executive and ARO) states:

“I have reviewed the proposed polling places in the review of parliamentary and local government polling districts and polling places. I am content that there are satisfactory places for polling stations that I could choose within all the proposed polling places that would meet the legal requirements for access for voters and would be suitable for a poll as required by electoral law.”

For the Erith and Thamesmead Constituency (the part in the Royal Borough of Greenwich), Jackie Belton (LB Bexley Chief Executive and ARO) was content with the proposals and stated that she had no further comments on the proposals.
